

**Description of Capability:** Minerva provides the ability, to authorize user credentials through multiple elements of user's identity. We have a two-factor authentication available in the application, that allows user to verify the credentials using a valid password associated with an email address/mobile number at one level and a (OTP) One Time Password at second level.

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
